The pancreas is an organ located behind the stomach. It releases enzymes that help with digestion, as well as hormones that help regulate blood sugar levels. If you have pancreatic cancer, you won't be able to feel a lump or mass when you press on the outside of your abdomen. You may not have any symptoms until the cancer has already spread.
